<b>STATEMENT</b>	The Algoma & Huron-Superior Transportation Services (AHSTS) consortium recognizes that students of joint custody parents may require special consideration regarding their transportation needs.	
<b>PROCEDURE</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. One address must be established as the “primary” address to which transportation services are applied. The alternate address is considered the “secondary” address and services to this address are assigned to the closest approved existing bus stop provided there is capacity available. The student is expected to walk to an existing stop for the secondary address.</li> <li>2. It is the parent’s/guardian’s responsibility to ensure that students in the primary grades (JK-3) get on/off at the secondary stop location. All JK students must be met by a parent/guardian or their designate.</li> </ol> <p>It is the ultimate responsibility of the parent to ensure that the student boards the proper bus and disembarks at the proper stop.</p>
